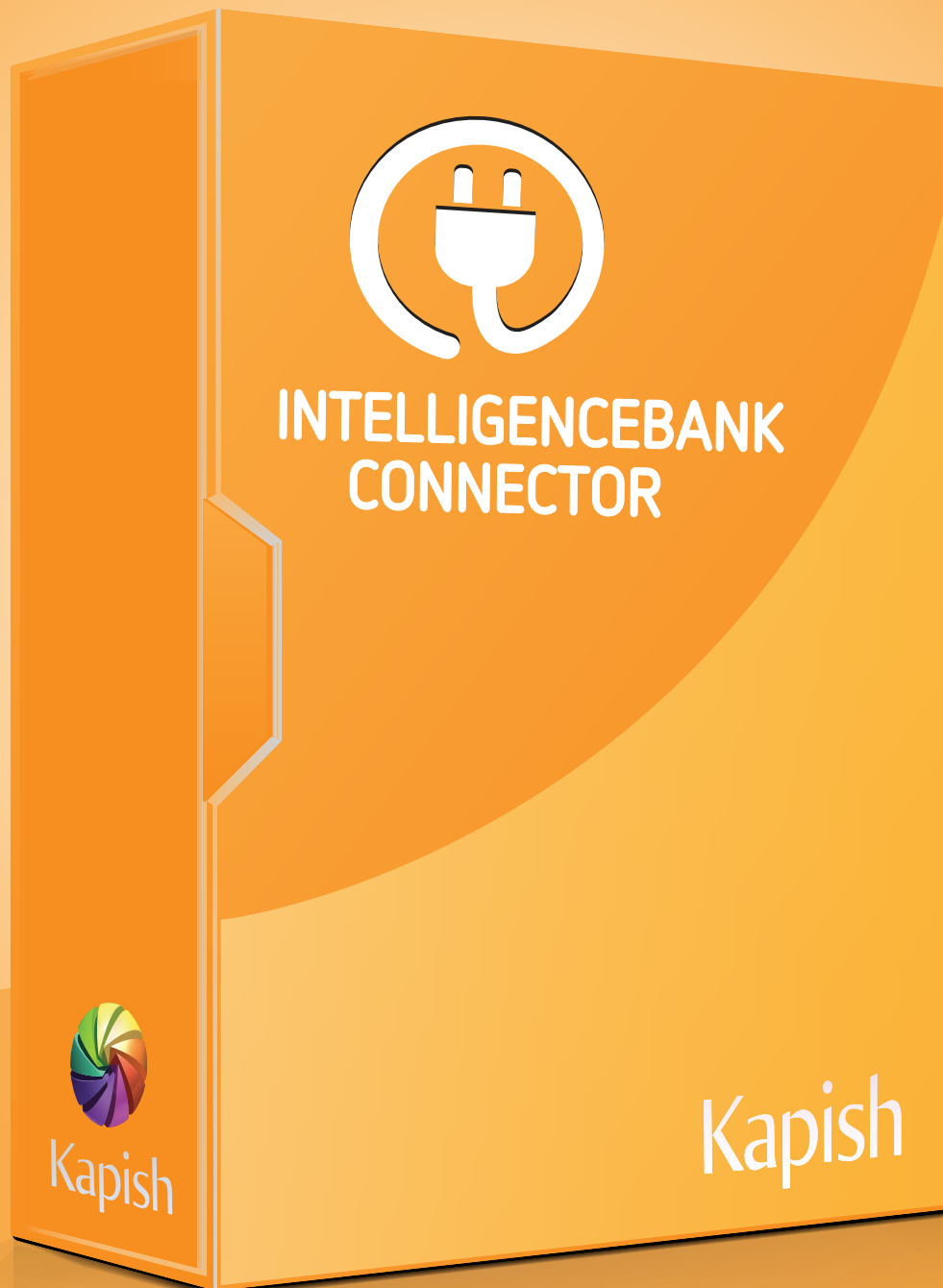

### Operating System Requirements

- CM 9.1 or later installed on the PC
- Microsoft .NET Framework 4.5.2 or later
- The minimum requirements set by your current version of Content Manager

### Information for IT Department

Kapish IntelligenceBank Connector is a client and server side application that works with IntelligenceBank and Content Manager to provide a link between both products. Software installation is via a Microsoft Installer (MSI) file, this can be run manually on each PC or via common network installation methods (e.g. SCCM, ZENworks, Group Policy etc.).
